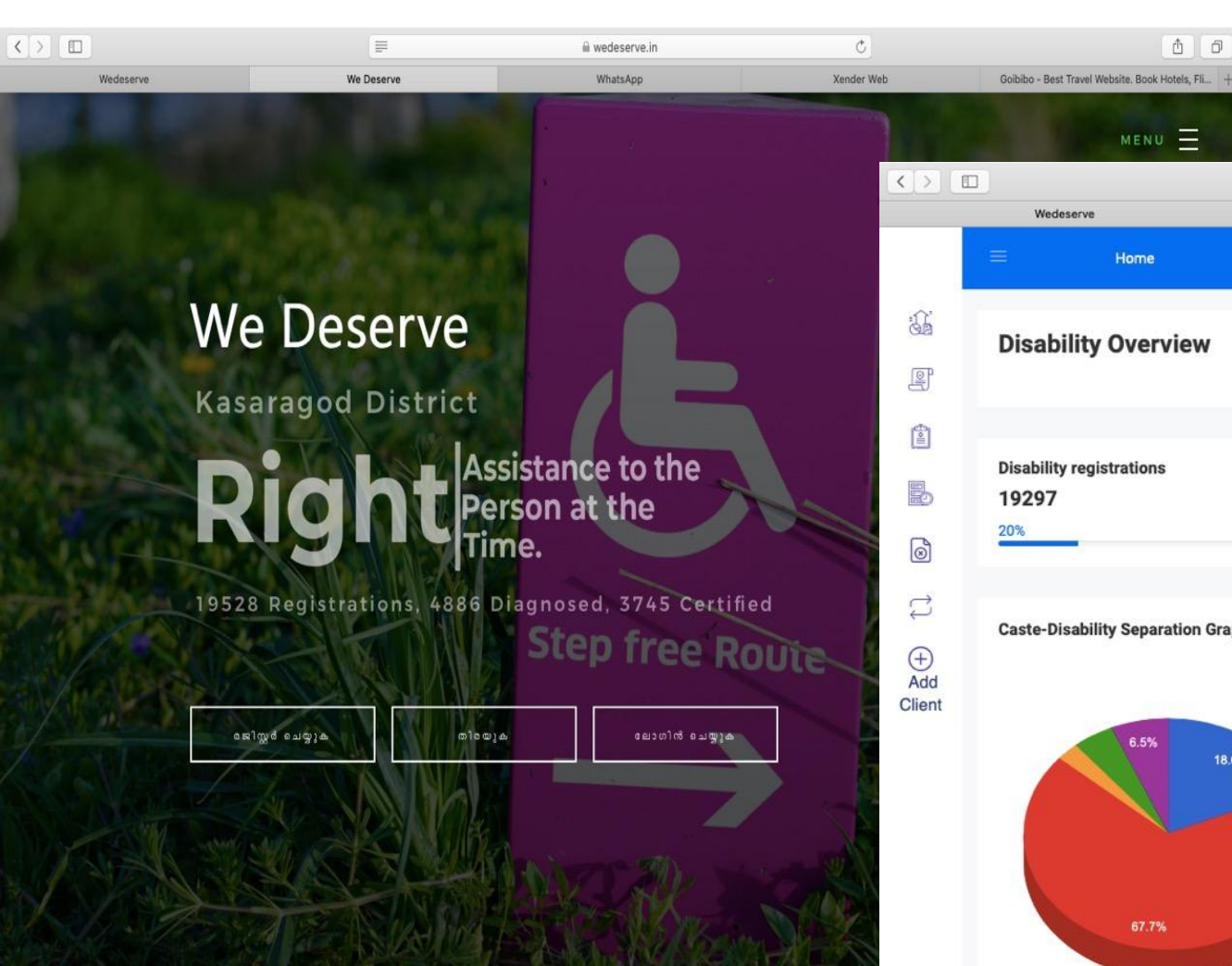

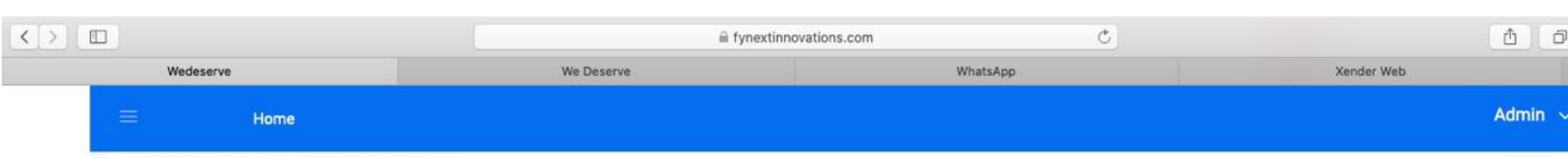


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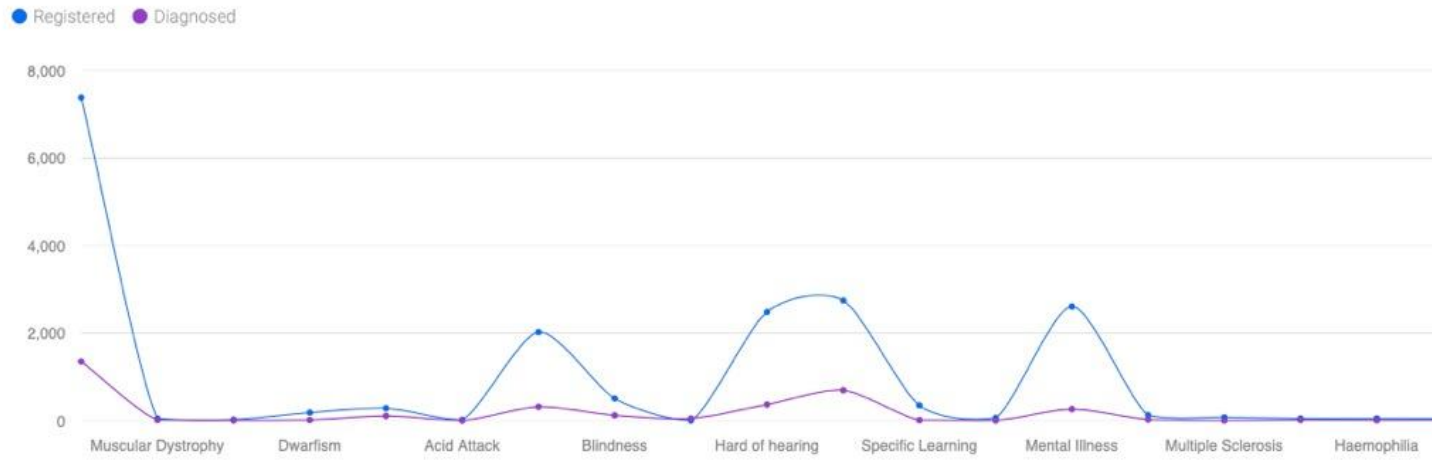
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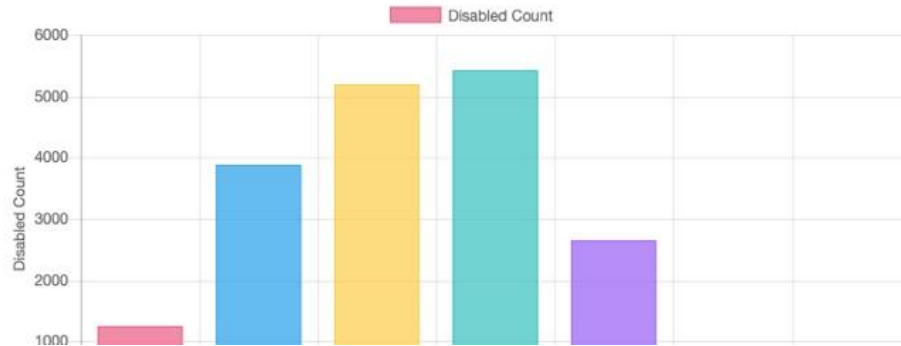
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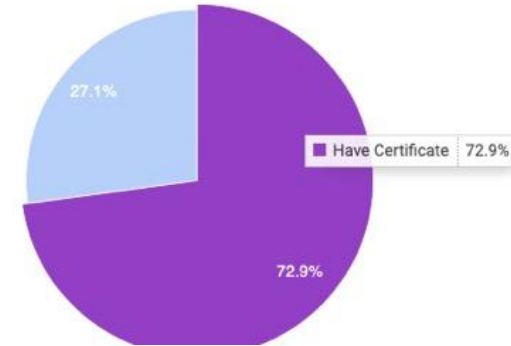
Registered vs Diagnosed Disability Graph

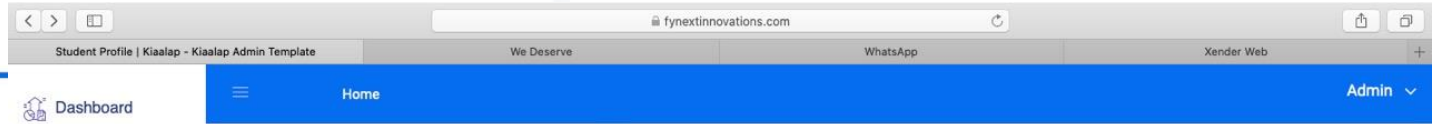

❑ Creating individual profile of each PWDS which includes personal, socio- economic, health (physical & mental) and education details and a comprehensive rehabilitation plan for each individual.

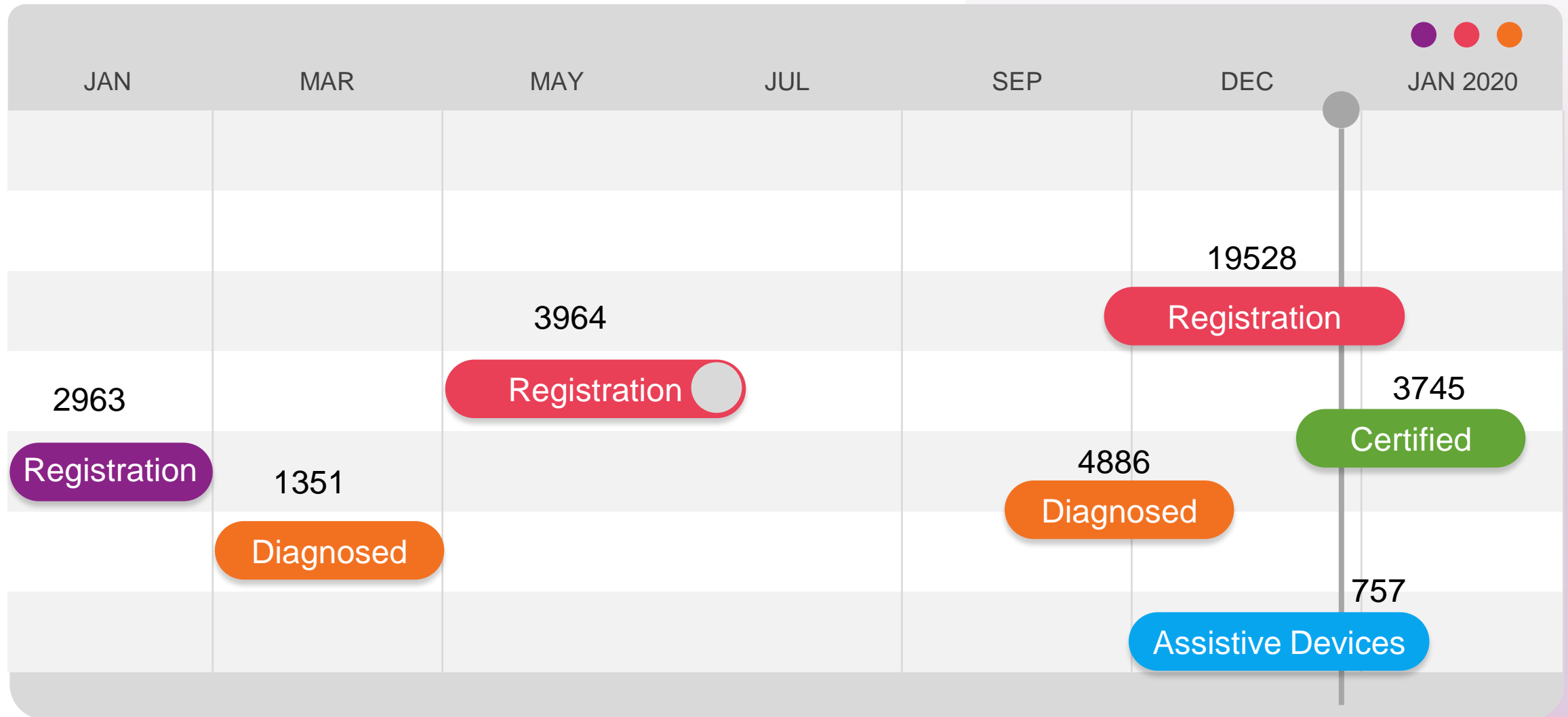
Advantages of New Strategy

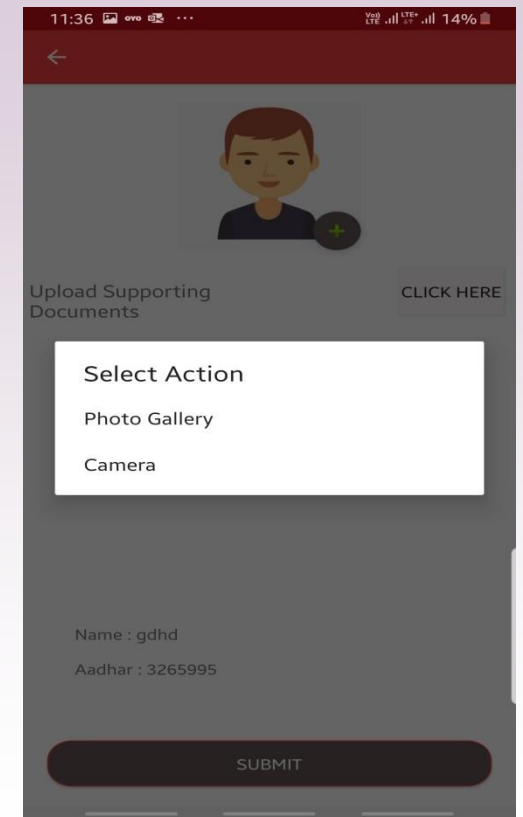
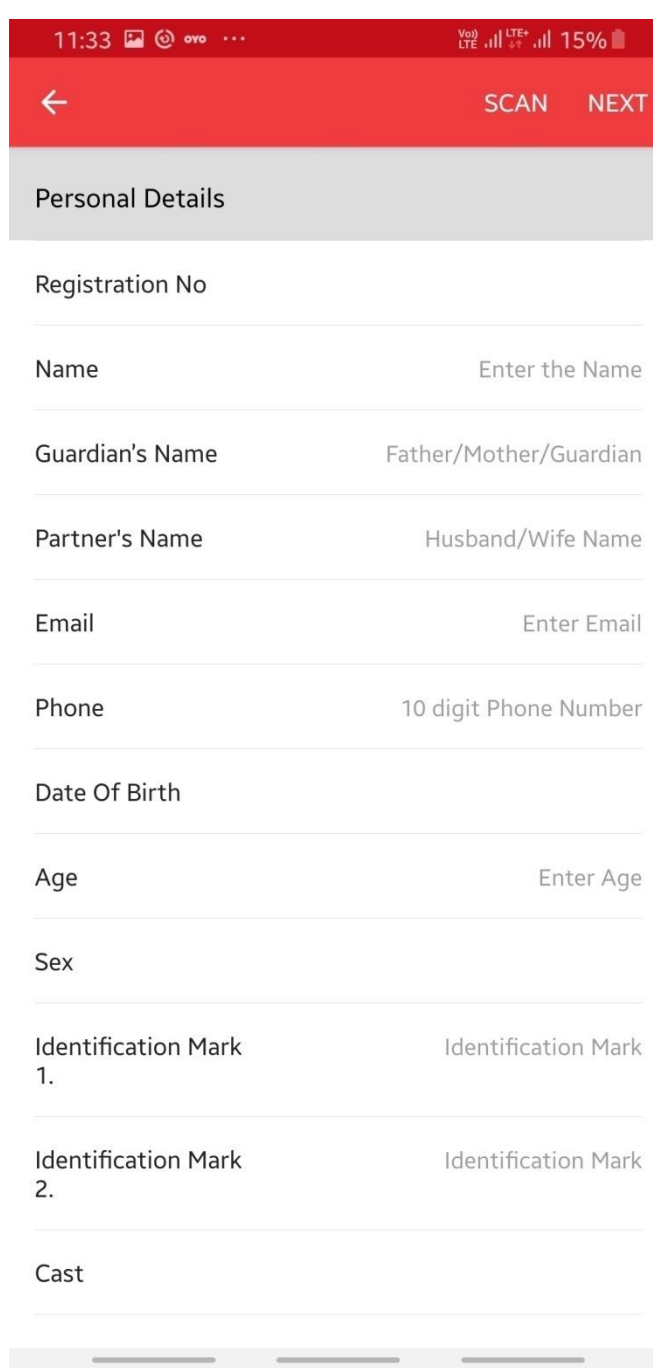
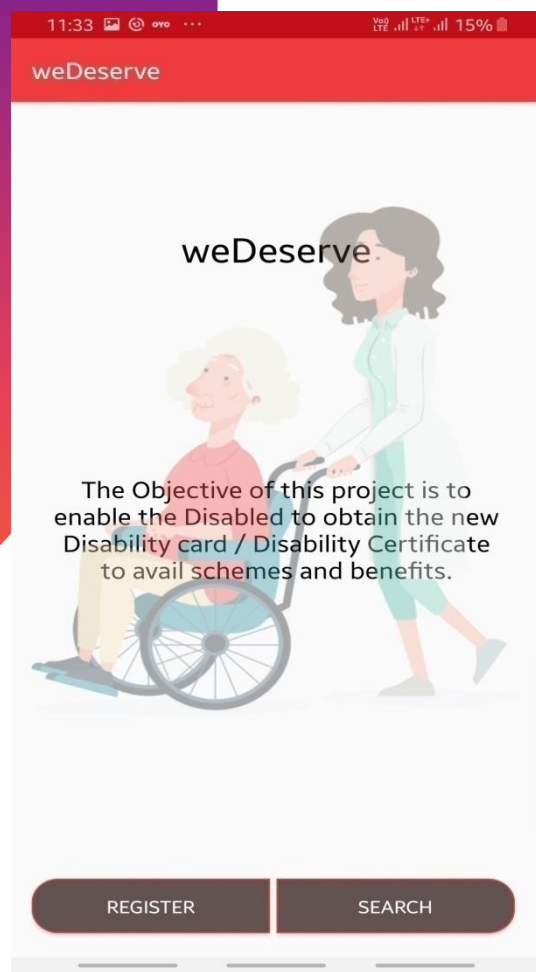
- ❖ The over dependence on the States for the correct and current data on disabled can be avoided
 - ❖ This makes Government authorities a better negotiator especially when programs like Direct Benefit Transfer [DBT] for the disabled is planned
 - ❖ The wastage of resources may be minimized
 - ❖ Government can decide on programmed and sub programs based on the number and types of disability with respect to its spatial distribution.
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Advantages of New Strategy

- The saving of resources can be maximized as with a click of the button the entire data on spatial disability distribution, types of disability distribution etc., can be gathered centrally. With such a data, pooling and allocation of resources including men, material, finance, expertise etc., can be rationally utilized without much wastage.
- The Union and State departments like the Planning & Finance, Social Welfare etc. can plan and design the programs effectively through this changed strategy
- The Local Self Government Department and Education Department can proactively distribute the various benefits in advance, without any scope for coercion and/or corruption, perfectly to the needy as and when such benefits are ready for distribution.
- This strategy would help the disabled to gather his/her benefits including the distribution of ID Cards at the site of his/her presence as and when it is ready for distribution, rather than going to various offices.
