It is an integrated and inter operable solution for extending e-Services related to rural areas of Uttar Pradesh. It comprises of online web applications of Land Records, RCCMS, *Bhu-Naksha* (Digitization of Cadastral Maps), *Khasra*(Crops details), Online Mutation and Anti-Bhu-Mafia Portal.

Key aspects are:

- All 7.65 crore revenue plots of U.P. State have been assigned a unique code of 16 digits. It is mandatory to mention plot code of a disputed plot at the time of filing a case to identify the type of plot.
- Bar Code, QR Code, DSCs, e-Sign, SMS, OTP etc., are being used in all the applications.
- The integration of all related applications is done through exchange of web services. Land records are integrated with banks, land registry, *Bhu-Naksha*, Paddy procurement, Agriculture Census, RCCMS etc.
- Digitally signed and QR code printed Record of Rights are easily available to the citizens through Common Service Centres, Lokwani Kendras, Tehsil Counters. One can view RoR online any time anywhere free of cost.
- Preservation of old *fasli Khataunis* in PDF, DB & e-Book forms.
- The details of all 90,000 out of 1.16 lacs digitized maps of revenue villages are available online.

Beneficiary of the project: Apart from benefiting the general public, it also benefits all rural land owners, all revenue officials and staff of U.P. State, advocates and Litigants. Moreover, it has also benefited the Revenue Department by bringing in ease and efficiency in their working process.

MahaRERA is an online application available for customers interested in buying real estate property within Maharashtra. Maharashtra is the pioneer State in implementation of the RERA and has taken the lead in streamlining/making all the services available to the citizens online. All the details about the projects, agents, promoters/builders, workers, contractors, vendors, banks and complaints are available online. It provides financial discipline, transparency, accountability in the real estate sector. For the citizen charter all the services available at MahaRERA are informed on the website of the authority. Project has the details for general citizen including GIS feature for project location and services in surrounding location.

MahaRERA has also established an adjudicating mechanism for speedy dispute redressal regarding registered real estate projects. It has made available the Complaints Module as well as Appellate Tribunal for the Citizen. The grievance redressal mechanism works completely online. As per the Act, 60 days are given for redressal of complaints and appeal. The average of MahaRERA and its Appellate Tribunal for grievance redressal is 47 days and 25 days respectively. MahaRERA has also made available to the public an email id to which people can forward their issues, suggestions and also provide a feedback. This email is monitored on a daily basis.

- Two healthcare experts (Pharmacist at sub center and Doctor at District Hospital) discuss a patient using conferencing system.
- District Health Society (DHS) for analyzing feedback of patients.
- Continuous monitoring of service using inspection and review meeting by dedicated team.

In comparison to traditional health service, benefits of “555” service:

1. Service access point is localized at block level in sub centers. It reduces constraints of terrain and topography.
2. Minimal or Zero Cost to Citizen. It reduces travelling cost along with high physical and emotional cost involved.
3. Reduction in travel time and distance to avail health service.
4. Real time service delivery.
5. Easy and universal access to doctor’s prescription and laboratory and diagnostics reports.
6. Feedback and Grievance Redressal Systems in one place.

Wind power forecasting services for the Whole state of Tamil Nadu

National Institute of Wind Energy

Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, Government of India.

A model for the forecasting of renewable energy, especially wind for load management. The project has developed a research-based model for prediction of wind forecasting and uses algorithms in the background. NIWE has created a state of art in house developed wind power forecasting model to forecast the wind power. In Tamil Nadu due to NIWE's forecast, evacuation of wind generation has been improved from 80 Million Units to 100+ Million Units in a day.

Key Innovation and Emerging Tech:

- National Institute of Wind Energy gets data from National Centre for Medium-Range Weather Research Forecasting (NCMRWF) and ISRO – Space Application Centre (ISRO-SAC) for developing the Indigenous wind power-forecasting model using the Indian Numerical Weather Prediction (NWP) data.
- Presently, NCMRWF is providing hourly wind speed forecast for 7 days in advance
- In addition, NIWE is also receiving 5 km (Regional Model) horizontal resolution NWP data for whole country. ISRO-SAC is providing 15 minutes wind speed forecast up to 72 hours ahead.
- The project employs Data Analysis & Modelling and GIS.

National JALMA Institute for Leprosy and Other Mycobacterial Diseases, Department of Health Research, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoH&FW), Government of India

A tribal population of 17 million is being covered by the project in 17 districts of 5 States, namely, Rajasthan, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Gujarat. 35 Mobile TB Diagnostic Vans (MTDV) have been deployed in these States which go to the remote villages and offer diagnostic services for TB in the village itself. Under this project, real-time data was collected on TB Life Cycle for more than 4000 Tuberculosis patients which enabled planning of services from a Mobile TB Diagnostic Van and community awareness, private practitioner sensitization and other such activities. Additionally, the software helped in ensuring treatment of patients diagnosed from the Mobile TB Diagnostic Van.

Outcomes of the Project:

- Increase in case detection of TB patients under the RNTCP
- Improvement in treatment adherence
- Increased community involvement
- Increased traditional healer involvement
- Improvement in community awareness
- Improved convenience to TB patients for diagnosis as well as for treatment.

Ultra resolution UAV based Geo-ICT enabled Property Tax Management System for Municipal Area of Bhiwani

District Administration Bhiwani

The MCB implemented a new GIS enabled property tax system developed by the Haryana Space Applications Centre, Department of Science and Technology. The project had the objectives of Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV)/ Drone based aerial mapping for the Municipal Area of Bhiwani and utilizing the feature extracted output as the base for the fresh property tax survey.

An Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) driven image was captured for the entire area under the jurisdiction of the civic body. This image was geo-referenced to convert image into map of the entire civic body. The digitization of this map with a very high resolution of 5 cm enabled automated assessment of dimension of the area of each and every property with in municipal area.

A smartphone based application was used to verify the assessments made using UAV based maps. This Geo-enabled system enabled MCB officials to assess property taxes, monitor defaults, authenticate the information and finally, to redress grievances

Beneficiary of the project: The beneficiaries are the Citizen and the Municipal Corporation as this has enabled transparency in the property tax calculation and collection.

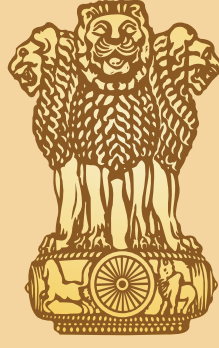
