Critique of NeGP

- Too slow in implementation
- No Mission-approach in MMPs
- Limited impact and visibility
- Isolated instances of Process Re-engineering
- Projects bound in red-tape
- Lack of interoperability
- Progress not uniform across the country
- State MMPs have not made much dent.

Slow progress of e-District

- Integrated Framework for delivery of Citizen Services
- Comprehensive guidelines issued in July 2012
 - Reference Architecture
 - Indicative Service Portfolio
 - Implementation Options
 - Model RFP
- Slow progress in States, despite regular monitoring
 - Only 13 States/UTs positioned SI after 18 months!
- Limited process re-engineering in e-Districts launched
